PUBLIC COMMENTS – Philip Crnkovich, Dubuque, spoke about the landfill expansion and how residents would be adversely affected by this.

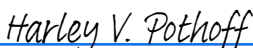

WORK SESSION – Discussion and possible action on Veto Request SF 659 Division XII Emergency Communication Services.
